

7 Day Discover the South West

Day 1

Drive from Perth to Margaret River via Bunbury and Busselton

Begin your South West escape with a drive from Perth to Margaret River stopping at Bunbury for lunch along the beautiful and newly redeveloped Koombana Bay foreshore precinct. Bunbury's Dolphin Discovery Centre is well worth a visit, before continuing your way south along the coast to Busselton. Located in picturesque Geographe Bay, Busselton is home to the longest timber piled jetty in the Southern Hemisphere! If you don't fancy walking the 1.8km Busselton Jetty, take the train to the Underwater Observatory at the end. Continue onto Margaret River and make yourself at home in the centrally located Margarets in Town Apartments.

Enjoy the Margaret River Region

Did we mention there is also a chocolate factory and plenty of locally produced cheeses!

Admire the white sand and turquoise waters of Denmark's Green Pool, then enjoy a picnic lunch at Elephant Rocks, taking in this unique landscape. Continue onto Albany and settle into your accommodation at the Albany Dog Rock Motel.

Albany Gap and Natural Wonders Tour


